



Females lay between six and 15 eggs that hatch after an incubation period of 60 to 75 days.

Water dragons can live for 10 to 15 years.

The Asian water dragon - also called the Thai, Chinese, or Green water dragon - is a dark to bright green lizard with high horn scales running from its head to its laterally flattened tail. The tail is banded in brown and green and ends in a fine point. When climbing, the water dragon uses its tail for balance and leverage, whipping it to defend itself against predators.
