In Number we are rolling a dice and using our subitising skills to match the number using our fingers and looking at different ways to make numbers up to 10. Some children are adding the dots on 2 dice together!

Next Week

We continue with Walking Through the Jungle but also share other books about animals such as: Monkey Puzzle by Julia Donaldson & Alex Scheffler, Look After Us by Rod Campbell and Gorilla by Anthony Browne, to name a few.

As well as sharing some amazing animal facts and videos, we are also teaching the children to be gentle and respectful of all animals, including **worms!**

In Phonics we are doing new letter sounds and learning their formation : 'ck' as in back, sack, pack.

The children are beginning to use their phonics knowledge to read short words (CVC words: consonant-vowel-consonant) eg: peg, pet, get.
