Year 1 Phonics Screening has been taking place this week. The pass mark will be released by the Government in a few weeks. Well done to everybody who has supported the children.

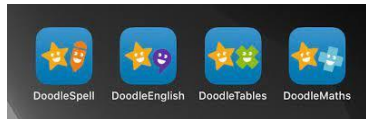
