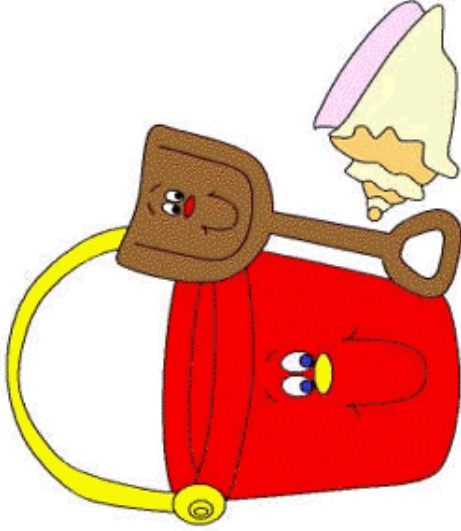


## At the Seaside

### Our Learning

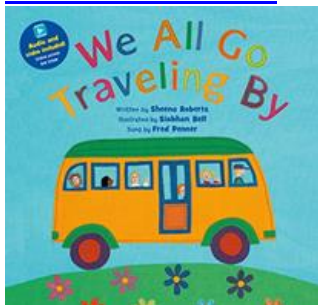
#### This Week
