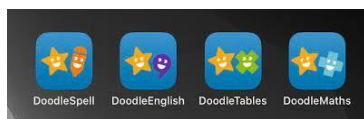

Maths

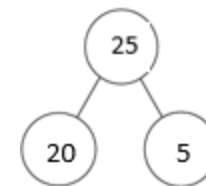
This week we looked at ordinal numbers.
