What We're Learning This Week!



Literacy

This week: We baked bread and then wrote a bread recipe.

Next week: Next week will be assessment week. The assessment will be: 'write about what you did on the weekend.'

Homework - Talk about what activities your child has done over the weekend and practice independence sentence writing with them.

Phonics

This week: we have been consolidating work on Phase 4 and 5 of the phonics: u-e for cube, u-e for flute, ue for blue and ue for argue. We have also looked at the tricky word 'people'.

Next week- we will continue to consolidate all the sounds from phase 4 and 5. We will also assess all the children on their phonics and reading.

Homework - Children should now be writing sentences independently using their knowledge of Phase 2/3/4/5 supported by tricky words.

Maths

This week- Our topic for this week was halving!

Key words: half, dividing by 2, 2 equal parts

Next week- Your child will be assessed on what they have been learning this term.

Homework- Please practice the following topics: halving, doubling, money, time, weight, height, length and positional language.
