




### Reading

### Literacy



This week we sequenced the story, focusing on what happened at the beginning, the order of characters pulling the turnip and what happened at the end.

Next week we will be looking at the different characters in the story and describing them. <u>Homework</u> - sequencing pictures in the correct order on a story map.

### Phonics

This week we continued to look at Phase 3 sounds and focused on these letters: **ai**, **ee**, **igh**, **and oa**.

Next week we will look at these sounds: (long) oo, (short) oo, ar, and or. <u>Homework</u> - Writing words to match the pictures, using this week's sounds.

### Maths

This week we have been looking at these 2D shapes: circle and triangle. Key words: sides, corners, straight, curved, round.

Next week we will be looking at the composition of the numbers: 4 and 5. <u>Homework</u> - I Spy, finding circles and triangles.
