Our Learning

This Week

The children have settled in quickly and are beginning to understand the routine during the session. Some children will become upset when they are left or later during the session, but please don't worry. Staff are here to help them and often just a small distraction is enough to stop the tears.

For toileting accidents and water play please make sure that children have spare clothes in school, which are labelled with their names. All children should also have a water bottle with their names on.

We have had lots of fun sensory play this week, including gloop, playdough, sand and paints! This is really important for your children's early development and helps them to build strength in their fine motor skills.

Next Week

We will continue to support your child with settling in to the routine, helping them to make choices and encouraging them to be independent.

The children are learning our nursery rules of 'kind hands and kind words' and the importance of sharing.

We are singing: 'Heads, shoulders, knees and toes' and using words to describe our bodies and painting pictures of ourselves.

Children's Centre services

Please note that you are still able to access the Children's centre services until your child is 5 years of age. Please see the attached timetable for sessions that you are able to attend.

Donations

We are planning to do lots of cooking over the next few terms in Nursery. For us to be able to do this we **kindly ask for your donations of £1** so that we can purchase ingredients. The money will also go towards ingredients for sensory play such as making Playdough, Cloud Dough, Rainbow pasta and more. These are all important for your children's development! So that we are ready for the inevitable runny noses, we would be very grateful if you could donate a box of tissue! Thank you.

Home Time

Your child's **safety** is **extremely** important to us. We ask that you form a queue and continue to be patient when we are calling your children's names. If somebody different is picking up your child, you must inform staff or call the school before pick up time. We will not send your child home if you do not inform staff of any changes. Therefore, please let us know in advance.

Health & Hygiene

Children should be entering the nursery without nappies or pull-ups. Please support children at home by encouraging them to be independent when going to the toilet. The Children's Centre (next door) may be able to provide support to parents in this area. We ask you to register with them as quickly as possible.

Please ensure your child's nails are cut short and filed down. We ask that you teach and show children how to properly clean their runny noses so that we can limit germs spreading within Nursery.

Punctuality & Absence

If your child is going to be absent, for whatever reason, please ensure that you ring the school office by 8.40am on 020 8573 3389 pressing **option 1** and leaving a message, stating your child's full name, class, and reason for absence.
