
Rhyme of the Week

What We're Learning This Week!



Literacy

This week: we have been writing about our favourite part of the story using conjunctions (because, and, also, but).

Next week: We will be writing a set of instructions on how to grow wheat. <u>Homework</u> - Continue to look at "The Little Red Hen" story map and work on retelling and sequencing the story with your child.

Phonics

This week: we have been consolidating work on Phase 4 and 5 of the phonics: ee, e-e, e and ey. We have also looked at the tricky word 'should'.

Next week- we will continue to consolidate all the sounds from phase 4 and 5 such as: ie for tie, ie for cookie, igh for high and i-e for smile.

<u>Homework</u> - Children should now be writing sentences independently using their knowledge of Phase 2/3/4/5 supported by tricky words. <u>PHONICS</u> HOMEWORK BOOK PAGES ARE: P.51-P.55 (WEEK 11)

<u>Maths</u>

This week- we have been learning about weight. We had lots of fun learning how to estimate the weight of items by becoming human weighing scales! We also compared weight.

'Key words: light, lightest, lighter, heavy, heavier, heaviest.

Next week- Our topic for next week is 'money'. Children will be learning different amounts! We will also be adding different amounts together.

Key words: 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p, 20p, altogether, pound, penny <u>Homework-</u> Please gather a range of different coins and go through the different amounts with your child.
