
This week we started working on a new book called 'Lima's Red Hot Chilli'. We learnt how to write questions and predictions.


Next week: We will continue our work with Lima's Red Hot Chilli and have a go at sequencing events of the story in order by thinking about what is the beginning, middle and end of the story.
