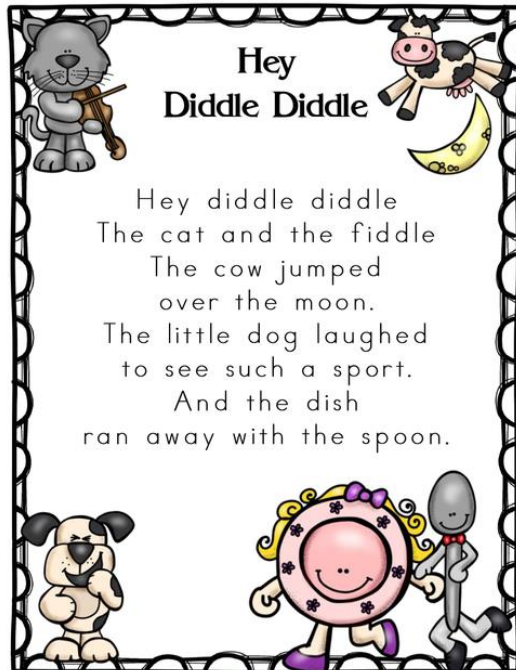

What We're Learning This Week!



Literacy

This week: We have been learning about how to grow wheat and how to write instructions to grow wheat.

Next week: We will be changing the characters in the story.

Homework - Continue to look at "The Little Red Hen" story map and work on retelling and sequencing the story with your child.

Phonics

This week: we have been consolidating work on Phase 4 and 5 of the phonics: ie for tie, ie for cookie, igh for high and i-e for smile. We have also looked at the tricky word 'people'.

Next week- we will continue to consolidate all the sounds from phase 4 and 5 such as: o-e for phone, ow for slow, oe for toe, ou for shout.

Homework - Children should now be writing sentences independently using their knowledge of Phase 2/3/4/5 supported by tricky words. **PHONICS**

Maths

This week- Our topic for this week was 'money'. Children learnt different amounts! We added different amounts together.

Key words: 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p, 20p, altogether, pound, penny

Next week- We will be doubling amounts up to 10. For example, $2+2=4$, $3+3=6$, $4+4=8$.

Key words: doubling, adding, more

Homework- Please practice doubling with your child using practical items around your home.
