

Maths

This week we have been learning about matching and sorting the objects. Next week, we will be learning to compare amounts.

<u>Homework</u> - Play the numbers game. Ask your children to get you 1 book, then 2 blocks, then 3 toys up to 10 and above etc. Try to count to the highest number possible. They need to practise counting objects correctly, using their finger to point to each object, and to count the numbers slowly, one count per object.
