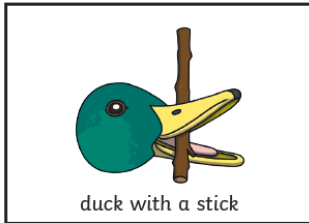


Today, we have been learning **ck**.



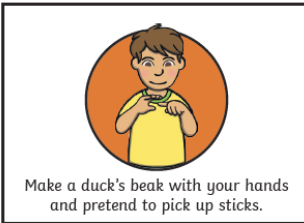

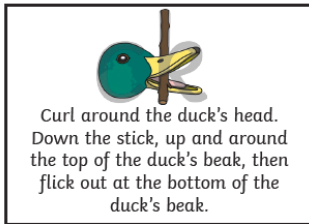
duck with a stick

Action



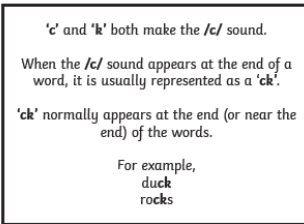
Make a duck's beak with your hands and pretend to pick up sticks.

Formation



Curl around the duck's head. Down the stick, up and around the top of the duck's beak, then flick out at the bottom of the duck's beak.

Double Letters



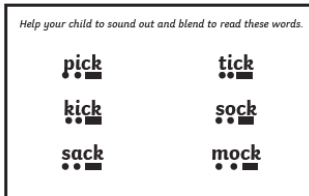
'c' and 'k' both make the /c/ sound.

When the /c/ sound appears at the end of a word, it is usually represented as a 'ck'.

'ck' normally appears at the end (or near the end) of the words.

For example,
duck
rocks

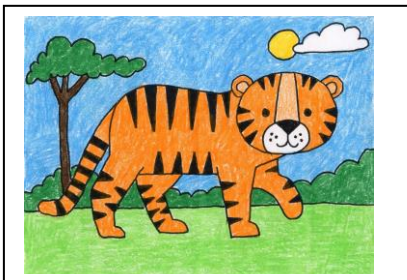

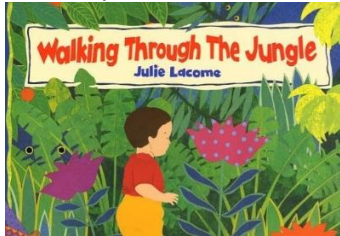

This week has been Mental Health Week! And the Nursery children have been busy visiting 'big school' for several assemblies including 'meet the snake', another Reception Assembly and ***Move It to help our Mental Health.***

Next Week

This is our last week before our half term break. Children's last day is Friday 24th and first day of Summer 2 is on Tuesday 4th June.

We will be focussing on number formation and practise so please help your child at home to support us, with numbers and name writing.

In Phonics we are doing new letter sounds and learning their formation : 'ck' as in back, sack, pack.

The children are beginning to use their phonics knowledge to read short words (CVC words: consonant-vowel-consonant) eg: peg, pet, get.

We will be reading a variety of stories to finish off the half term as well as practising songs and poems for our assembly.

In Number we are practising our counting skills and using 10 frames.
