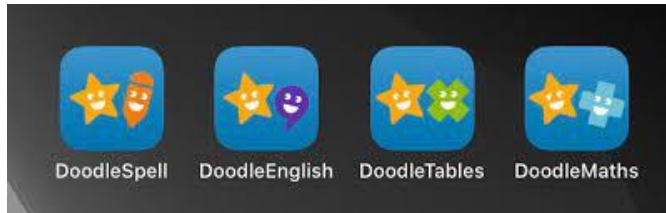

Next Week- We will be sequencing the story through pictures and creating a detailed story map.

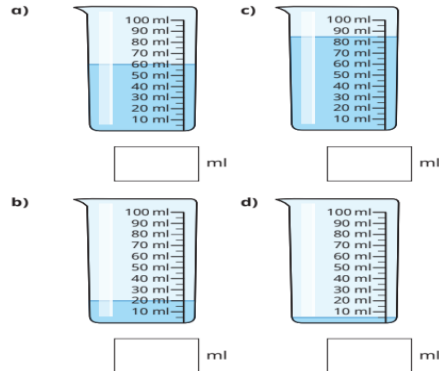

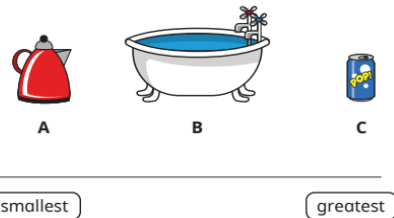
Mathematics

1 How much water is there in each beaker?



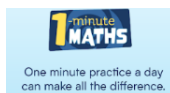
7 Put the objects in order of how much water they can hold.
