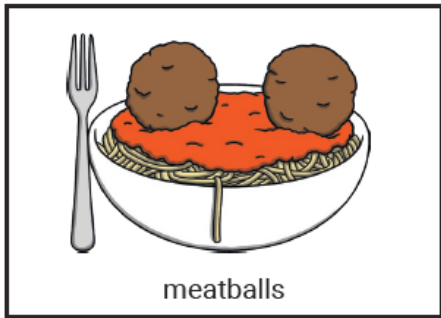


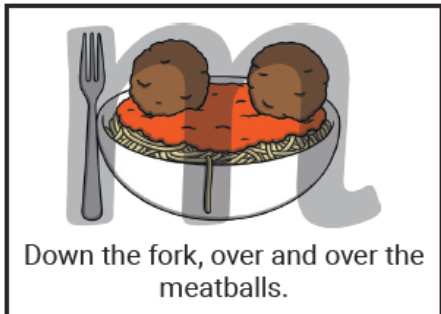

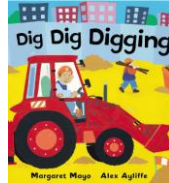
In maths, we focussed on recognising numerals 1-5 and putting them into the correct order.
