


Meet The Teacher



Reading

- Little and often e.g. books, labels, signs
- Ask comprehension questions e.g. why, what who, when, which,
- Let your child make predictions
- Talk about new words
- Review the book/story
- Write a comment in the reading record book
- Library book is taken home once a week

- Ensure that your child has his/her book bag daily
- Encourage changing the reading book on the book changing days i.e. Tuesday.
- Teaching of reading is also done through shared, guided reading and phonics.
- Children's book levels may change based on both their comprehension and sight reading skills.



As little as 10 minutes per day will make a HUGE difference!!

Attendance

- An important issue children who succeed at school are those who attend.

WORKING TOGETHER - What can you do

to get your child ready for Nursery?

-All children must be able to use the toilet independently. Please keep a spare pair of clothes on their peg in a clearly named bag for accidents.

-Children need to be able to get themselves dressed and undressed independently, practice putting on their coats on their own at home. -Share reading books everyday with them - visit the library if possible. -Sing Nursery Rhyme songs to your child.

- Also when returning forms, please fill out all the details including signatures and dates if required.
